RE: Plano Premier League Playing Format Fall 2013-Spring 2014

U11

- Each team will have the chance to enter into the placement tournament to help determine the team placement for D1, D2, D3 (D4 if applicable)
- Any team that chooses not to participate will automatically be placed in the lowest division
- D1 will have 19 teams and the remainder of the teams will be placed in D2 or D3 if applicable
- Byes may be issued by VP of Competitive.
- Awards will be issued in the spring only and to the top 2 teams in D1.

U12-U14

- Each of these age groups will have 10 teams in D1 and D2 and the remainder of the teams will be placed in D3 or D4 if applicable
- All teams must have N+1 from the Spring Roster as of April 1, 2013 to be considered for a BYE.
- From the F12/S13 standings the top 10 teams in D1 will receive a BYE and will be F13's D1
- If a PPL D1 top 10 team does not return or makes Classic/Lake Highlands we will accept a Classic or Lake Highlands team in their place. With N+1
- 4 BYES will be given in D2 leaving 6 places for qualification. Team's in 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> place from F12/S13 D1 will be offered a BYE and 2 other BYES will be offered at the discretion of the VP Competitive, this may include the top teams from D2.
- At the end of the fall season awards will be presented to the top 2 teams in D1 and D2
- Then the top two teams in D2 will be promoted to D1 and the bottom two teams in D1 will be relegated to D2. All points will be removed.
- At the end of the spring season awards will be given to the top 2 teams in D1 and D2

\*D3/D4 groups may not have parity of play

\*N+1 is based on your roster as of April 1, 2013 and is half your roster size plus 1. For example if you have 18 players then you need 10 returning players to maintain your N+1.

## U15-U16

- Each of these age groups will have 9 teams in D1 and D2 (if we have enough) and the remainder of the teams will be placed in D3 or D4 if applicable
- All teams must have N+1 from the Spring Roster as of April 1, 2013 to be considered for a BYE.
- From the F12/S13 standings the top 9 teams in D1 will receive a BYE and will be F13's D1
- If a PPL D1 top 9 team does not return or makes Classic/Lake Highlands we will accept a Classic or Lake Highlands team in their place. With N+1



- 4 BYES will be given in D2 leaving 5 places for qualification. Team's in 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> place from F12/S13 D1 will be offered a BYE and 2 other BYES will be offered at the discretion of the VP Competitive, this may include the top teams from D2.
- At the end of the fall season awards will be presented to the top 2 teams in D1 and D2
- Then the top two teams in D2 will be promoted to D1 and the bottom two teams in D1 will be relegated to D2. All points will be removed.
- At the end of the spring season awards will be given to the top 2 teams in D1 and D2 \*D3/D4 groups may not have parity of play

\*N+1 is based on your roster as of April 1, 2013 and is half your roster size plus 1. For example if you have 18 players then you need 10 returning players to maintain your N+1.

U17-U19

- If there is more than 18 teams there will be a placement tournament.
- Merging of the age groups is at the discretion of the VP of Competitive.
